Example Round 9:

Basic summary for player JONES ninth round: Overall 16.8 points is slightly above average but is still a good round. Jones was rewarded by picking the underdog Adelaide with 3 points but lost 4 points on trying to win safe points with favourite Port and lost one point with Sydney. Jones' hunch on the Roos lost him 2 points. The perfect round would have been 41.1 points by picking all winners with 9 NWTC points on the underdogs Fremantle (which paid 3.2 totalling 28.8).

Six (6) games correct out of eight (8) for a total of 28.55 points.

Basic summary for player Smith ninth round: 28.55 points is a very strong round and close to the perfect round of 41.1 points. Smith was rewarded by picking the underdog Fremantle with 5 points to collect 16 points from the one game. Smith played safe with the favourite Collingwood and collected 6.5 from his 5 points. Smith also played safe by tipping one point on the favourites for the remaining 6 games in which 4 winning tips came through.
